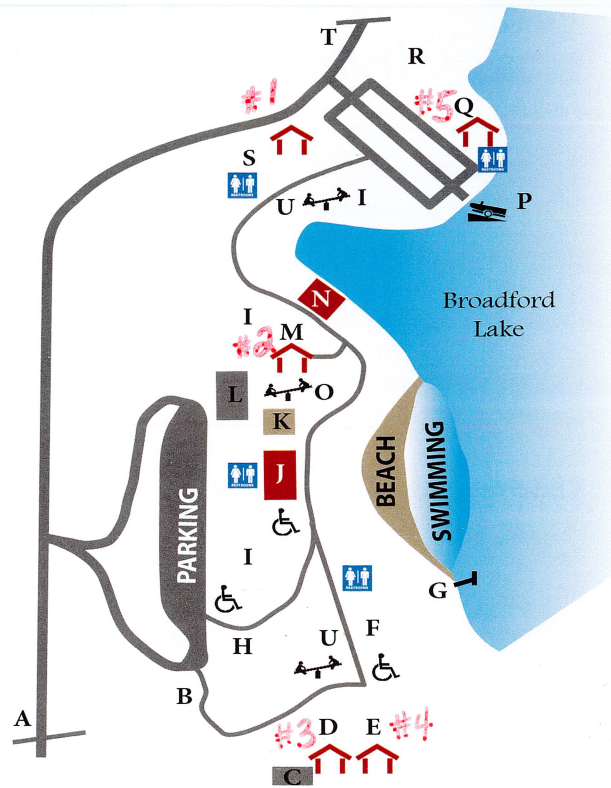


Broadford Park Rules & Regulations

1. If you have a problem please notify park personnel immediately.
2. Please observe the 15 M.P.H. speed limit; children are at play and wildlife sometimes wander on the roads.
3. Keep all vehicles on roadway and/or parking areas unless otherwise directed by park staff or Oakland Police.
4. Roadways used to access pavilions are not parking areas. They are to be used for unloading/ loading only. Parking spaces at pavilions 2, 3, and 4 are for handicapped or medical necessity only.
5. Swimming is permitted only at the beach area with adult supervision. Beach is unprotected.
6. At any sign of lightning or other serious weather, all individuals are to exit the water for the period of time currently recommended by the American Red Cross.
7. For safety, only individuals wearing a certified life preserver can access park docks.
8. Rental boats are available and provide fun for the whole family.
9. Life preservers are to be worn at all times while in a rental boat.
10. Broadford Lake requires a Maryland Fising License (16 and over). All State fishing regulations apply.
11. Boating regulations are located at the boat launch.
12. Gasoline containers and gasoline engine boats are not permitted on Broadford Lake. Come enjoy quiet peaceful recreation.
13. Broadford Lake is a quiet and peaceful environment and excessive noise will not be tolerated. Those wishing to play music should rent pavilions 1, 2, and 5 and keep volumes low enough as to not offend other park guests.
14. Alcoholic beverages are permitted at your table only.
15. No smoking in restrooms, on rental boats, or in beach area.
16. Place all trash and food leftovers in provided dumpsters.
17. Please be courteous to other park guests.
18. Anyone exhibiting unruly behavior or disregarding Park Regulations and/or Policies will be removed without refund and may become involved in the judicial process.
